

Transcript of Program Industrial Board

The Program Industrial Board held a meeting on 21.10.2020 to review the program learning outcomes and curriculum of program Management of Real Estate and Infrastructure (BA) tasked Mr. Gent Sejdiu to serve from now on as a minute taker.

The Program Industrial Board also reviewed the final draft of learning outcomes proposed by the Curriculum Development Team of College ESLG, which were also approved by the construction industry representatives at joint meetings with Curriculum Development Team. At this meeting, the members of the Program Industrial Board approved the conclusions of joint meeting between Program Industrial Board members and Curriculum Development Team as it can be seen on page 9 of the Procedure for Approval of Curriculum available online in http://www.eukos.org/repository/docs/Procedure_of_approval_of_review_of_curricula_2020.pdf

The Program Industrial Board reviewed the proposals for learning outcomes of the new study program Management of Real Estate and Infrastructure and concluded that the learning outcomes are in compliance with the industry skills needed to excel and at the same time are in full accordance with Kosovo National Qualifications Framework and Qualifications of the European Higher Education Area for Level 6 education.

The Program Industrial Board notes that the learning outcome Gather and interpret data of financial real estate transactions to establish judgment related to real estate investments received a 65 % acceptance by surveyed industry representatives and this learning outcome will add value to business only if real-time real estate investments of companies are included in the class as part of curriculum and as part of student assessment.
